

## JULIA NICHOLSON



Julia Nicholson studied at the Slade School, UCL, 1962-7, gaining a landscape painting scholarship in 1964.

1968-72 she exhibited at the Royal Academy diploma galleries, also in Grafton St. and the South London Art Gallery.

Family and teaching occupied the '70s, and in 1980 the family moved to a small Aberdeenshire farm.

From 1986 she was painting seriously again; landscape and the immediate world were the subjects.

In 1998 she became a 'gallery artist' with Hanover Fine Arts, Dundas St., Edinburgh, exhibiting 3 or 4 times a year until 2009.

2003 saw a large 6-week exhibition in Holland; 2006 a 2-artist 6-week show at Duff House (part of the National Galleries of Scotland) and a 6-artist show at Kinblethmont House, Arbroath.

She has had several commissions including a double portrait and a family portrait. She has shown work in 6 Aberdeenshire galleries and has participated in North East Open Studios over 4 years.

At present she is working to develop new structures and meanings in paintings of people and relationships.
